PLACE AND TIME

The IInd International Competition "MUSICA PIANOFORTE" will be held at Prienai cultural and leisure centre concert hall in June 5-7, 2015. The performances will be held in June 5-6, 2015. The closing ceremony of the competition will take place at Prienai cultural centre concert hall on the 7 of June, 2015. (Considering the number of the participants, the date of the gala ceremony may change.)

PARTICIPANTS

The competition is open for pianists–soloists, piano ensembles (four hands, six hands, eight hands (only on one piano!)) and instrumental chamber ensembles (only duets, trios and quartets with piano obligatory). The teachers can't be on the staff.

The number of participants of the competition is limited. Date of dispatching the applications will be considered in case.

COMPETITION PROCEDURE

It is one - round competition.

Competitors will be divided into the following categories:

SOLOISTS CATEGORIES (A)

The queue of the soloists in all categories will be arranged according to the age of participants.

REPERTOIRE (soloists)

The soloists in all categories must perform 2-3 compositions:

- a) Baroque or Classical composition(s);
- b) Romantic or 20-21st century academic music composition(s).

Note: The programme should consist of pieces reflecting different moods. It is not obligatory to repeat certain movements in the compositions.

All pieces must be performed by heart.

PIANO ENSEMBLE CATEGORIES (B)

CHAMBER ENSEMBLE CATEGORIES (C)

C1	The average age of all the participants of an ensemble shouldn't exceed 10 year.	up to 5 min.	60 Eu
C2	The average age of all the participants of an ensemble shouldn't exceed 13 year.	up to 8 min.	60 Eu
C3	The average age of all the participants of an ensemble shouldn't exceed 16 year.	up to 12 min.	60 Eu

The queue of the ensembles in both categories will be arranged according to the age of participants and the number of instruments (duets, trios, quartets)

REPERTOIRE (B and C ensemble categories)

The ensembles in all categories must perform 2-3 compositions:

- a) 17-19th century composition(s);
- b) 20-21st century composition(s).

Note: The programme should consist of pieces reflecting different moods. It is not obligatory to repeat certain movements in the compositions.

It is forbidden to use phonograms at the performance.

On the arrival at the competition you won't be allowed to make changes.

JURY

The performances will be judged by an International Jury appointed by the organizer.

The Jury's decisions will be final and not the subject to appeal.

The decisions of the Jury will be announced publicly at the place of the competition.

The Jury keeps the right to interrupt the performance exceeding the time limit.

Students of the Jury members can't participate in the competition.

AWARDS AND PRIZES

The laureate diplomas will be handed to the most highly evaluated participants of the competition.

Grand Prix – will be awarded in each category (A, B, C). Grand Prix winners with the highest marks in each category will be presented with money prizes.

At the Gala concert will perform all the winners of Grand Prix and the winners appointed by the jury and the organizers.

These winners of Grand Prix, who won't attend the Gala ceremony, won't be presented with money prizes.

The Competition reserves the right to the recordings of all live performances and concerts of the Competition without any compensation to the competitors. This applies to any format including but not limited to audio, video recordings, radio and TV broadcasts.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

Entries must be made on the attached Application Form and must reach the Competition Secretary before the **15 of March, 2015**.

The following documents should be included with the Application Form:

- a) a copy of birth certificate or passport (it is necessary to have the original on the arrival at the Competition);
- b) and official confirmation of payment of the fee.

For the participants in categories **B, C** (ensembles) – 60 Eur
